1. Travel from HK Airport to Hotels / Hostels

For directions from the HK Airport to the two designated hotels, i.e. Hyatt Regency HK Hotel in Shatin / Royal Park Hotel or to the S.H. Ho Hostel at CUHK (on-campus accommodation), please refer to the section 'Transportation' at: http://www.bch.cuhk.edu.hk/enzyme2013/.

2. Transportation from Designated Hotels to Conference Venue (Mong Man Wai Building, CUHK) from 17-20 June

(An usher will show the sign of NAEEHD Conference 2013 at the hotel lobby before departure time)

8:20 am coach leaving at Royal Park Hotel, Shatin

8:35 am coach leaving at Hyatt Regency HK Hotel, Shatin

3. Welcoming Dinner on 16 June (Sunday) – 6:30 pm at Staff Common Room, CUHK

We will host a welcoming dinner to attending scientists on 16 June 2013 at 6:30 pm at Staff Common Room (Guest House), CUHK. If you are able to join, please sign up with Celia at celia-poon@cuhk.edu.hk before 11 June and advise her your travel plan and the hotel that you will be staying at (if not at University hostel). We may arrange pick-up at the two designated hotels. Tentatively, 6 pm departing at Royal Park Hotel; 6:15 pm departing at Hyatt Regency Hotel, Shatin, depending on number of participants attending the welcoming dinner. We will post the arrangements on the web after 11 June. Staff Common Room at CUHK is just about 5 minutes' walk from the S.H. Ho Hostel.

4. Registration

5. Weather
